The University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA), has submitted a request to designate the intersection of Tiverton Avenue and Le Conte Avenue (at the southeastern end of the campus) as "David Geffen Square." The proposed square will honor David Geffen's extraordinary philanthropy and impacts to health, education, and medical research.

David Geffen exemplifies the optimism and spirit of innovation that are hallmarks of UCLA. Through his generous dedication to UCLA, the University wants to commemorate his visionary philanthropy across various sectors. His generous support for medical education and research to the School of Medicine, has had a transformative impact on medical research.

In September 2016, UCLA plans to host a dedication and unveiling of "David Geffen Square." The proposed square located at the corner of Tiverton Avenue and Le Conte Avenue will serve as the community's gateway to David Geffen Hall.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the intersection of Tiverton Avenue and Le Conte Avenue, in the Westwood Community be named "David Geffen Square" in recognition of his extraordinary philanthropy and impacts to health, education and medical research in the City of Los Angeles, and that the Department of Transportation be directed to fabricate and install permanent ceremonial signs to this effect at this location, in consultation with Council District 5.
