

HEALTH, MENTAL HEALTH, AND EDUCATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the feasibility of setting aside future parcel tax funding to support a Citywide Joint Use Agreement with the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) for open/recreational space.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Ryu - Price):

1. INSTRUCT the Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) and the City Administrative Officer (CAO) to report on how future parcel tax funding, such as the next version of Proposition A, can be set aside to support a Citywide Joint Use Agreement with the LAUSD.
2. INSTRUCT the RAP, with assistance from the CAO, to report on:
 - a. The ways that Measure A funds can be used to support capital improvements or maintenance at joint use sites.
 - b. How a Joint Use Application Program could be created for schools to apply to in order to enter into a Joint Use Agreement with the City in return for capital improvements and maintenance support from Measure A or other funding sources.
3. INSTRUCT the RAP to:
 - a. Report with an update on the expansion of Joint Use Agreements and their successes and challenges.
 - b. Report within 30 days from November 8th on these instructions if Measure A passes.


Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Summary:

On September 26, 2016, the Health, Mental Health, and Education Committee considered Motion (Ryu - Price) relative to the feasibility of setting aside future parcel tax funding to support a Citywide Joint Use Agreement with the LAUSD for open/recreational space. The Motion, attached to the Council file, provides background information. During the discussion of this item, representatives from the RAP and the CAO appeared before the Committee and responded to related questions. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council approve the Motion as amended in Committee and detailed above.
