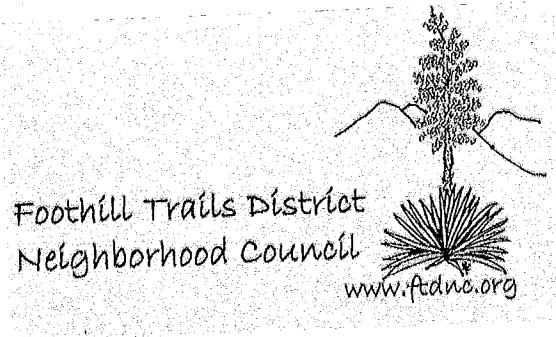


### Community Impact Statement Council File #16-1068

At the General Board meeting of the Foothill Trails District Neighborhood Council held on October 20, 2016, the board members voted (8) yes (0) no (0) abstain to **SUPPORT** CF #16-1068 the City Council's opposition to the Refined E2 Alignment for the California High Speed Rail Authority's Palmdale-to-Burbank project segment, and any other alignments that would cross any natural segments of the Los Angeles River and its tributaries, including the Big Tujunga Wash, at or above grade within the City of Los Angeles..

The Foothill Trails District and its surrounding communities have been held in limbo for the last two years by the CAHSRA's refusal to act on the community's requests to eliminate the above ground elements that would destroy the Tujunga Wash and cause many residents to lose their homes.

We are very appreciative to Council Members Krekorian, Wesson and O'Farrell for taking a step forward in representing our local communities and addressing our concerns.
