Recommendation for Council action:



Summary:

At a meeting held on February 1, 2017, the Energy and Environment Committee considered a report from the Board of Public Works dated August 26, 2016 relative to a request from the BOS for authorization to implement the SLAGAMP as one of the first of many Green Alleys Handbooks that can be used as a model for developing green alleys in other communities in the City, Los Angeles County, and around the State.
