

PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to reimbursing the Palos Verdes Peninsula Land Conservancy for landscape and irrigation work for the restoration of areas of the White Point Nature Preserve damaged by White Point Landslide mitigation construction projects.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Buscaino – Bonin), SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. AUTHORIZE the Board of Public Works to expend \$47,336.30 from the Special Gas Tax Street Improvement Fund No. 206/50 White Point Landslide-Slope Anchor Mitigation, Appropriation No. 50JKAK, to reimburse the Palos Verdes Peninsula Land Conservancy for landscape and irrigation work that was performed to restore areas of the White Point Nature Preserve that were damaged by the White Point Landslide mitigation construction projects.
2. AUTHORIZE the Controller to make any technical corrections or clarifications necessary to carry out this action.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On November 23, 2016, Council considered Motion (Buscaino – Bonin) relative to reimbursing the Palos Verdes Peninsula Land Conservancy for landscape and irrigation work for the restoration of areas of the White Point Nature Preserve damaged by White Point Landslide mitigation construction projects. Motion states that in 2011, an approximately 400-foot section of the Paseo Del Mar roadway collapsed due to the White Point Landslide. Several construction projects were performed to mitigate the landslide. As a result of these projects, restoration activities were necessary to affected areas of the adjacent White Point Nature Preserve.

Motion goes on to state that the contractor for the construction projects was unable to undertake the restoration project because the construction activities were completed outside of the planting season for the native vegetation. The Palos Verdes Peninsula Land Conservancy agreed to perform the restoration work and to be reimbursed by the City. The work was completed several months ago and the Bureau of Engineering needs authorization to pay the invoice from the Conservancy. Motion recommends payment in the amount of \$47,336.30 to Palos Verdes Peninsula Land Conservancy for the restoration work. Council referred Motion to the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee for consideration.

At its meeting held January 23, 2017, the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee recommended that Council approve Motion.
