Summary: The BABCNC supports proposed new HCR additions signed by CM Koretz & CM Ryu on April 2, 2019 in Council File #16-1472-S6, “that the Council instruct the Planning Department, with the assistance of the Department of Building and Safety, Bureau of Engineering, and the Department of Transportation, and in consultation with the City Attorney, and any other relevant City department, to prepare and present an Ordinance that incorporates the following amendments discussed above to the Bel Air-Beverly Crest Hillside Construction Regulation Supplemental Use District, relative to: (1) notification to hillside residents for both haul route and demolition permit activity; (2) ensure that Neighborhood Councils have the opportunity to provide comment on haul routes; (3) ensure that graded and hauling activity is not taking place in advance of a project being approved; and, (4) earmark a funding source that will be used to make repairs and improvements to the hillside street infrastructure com: the cumulative wear and tear that results from large construction-related vehicles.” The BABCNC voted 26/0/0 to write a letter to the Council District asking for an addendum to the already approved document to include (5) In addition; to put a cap on cumulative slope banding not to exceed 45 feet.
