

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a Special Election was ordered to be held in the City of Los Angeles pursuant to Ordinance No. 184403 to place a measure before the voters and the election was consolidated with the State General Election held November 8, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the following measure was submitted to a vote of the qualified voters of the City of Los Angeles:

AFFORDABLE HOUSING AND LABOR STANDARDS RELATED TO CITY PLANNING. INITIATIVE ORDINANCE JJJ.

Shall an ordinance: 1) requiring that certain residential development projects provide for affordable housing and comply with prevailing wage, local hiring and other labor standards; 2) requiring the City to assess the impacts of community plan changes on affordable housing and local jobs; 3) creating an affordable housing incentive program for developments near major transit stops; and 4) making other changes; be adopted?

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk canvassed the returns for the Special Municipal Election consolidated with the State General Election held in the City of Los Angeles on November 8, 2016, and certified the results to the Los Angeles City Clerk on December 2, 2016, with such certification attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the City Council that the canvass of votes is true and correct.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Los Angeles City Council hereby finds, determines, and declares that the total number of votes cast for and against City of Los Angeles Initiative Ordinance JJJ at the Special Municipal Election by the qualified voters was 1,136,924 as set forth in the certificate of the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk, and that the proposition, as proposed by Resolution of the City Council, is hereby declared to have been approved by a majority of the voters voting thereon.
