

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a Special Election was ordered to be held in the City of Los Angeles pursuant to Ordinance No. 184407 to place a measure before the voters and the election was consolidated with the State General Election held November 8, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the following measure was submitted to a vote of the qualified voters of the City of Los Angeles:

CITY OF LOS ANGELES FIRE AND POLICE PENSIONS; AIRPORT PEACE OFFICER. CHARTER AMENDMENT SSS.

Shall the Charter be amended to: (1) enroll new Airport peace officers into Tier 6 of the Fire and Police Pension System; (2) allow current Airport peace officers to transfer into Tier 6 from the City Employees' Retirement System (LACERS) at their own expense; and (3) permit new Airport Police Chiefs to enroll in LACERS?

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk canvassed the returns for the Special Municipal Election consolidated with the State General Election held in the City of Los Angeles on November 8, 2016, and certified the results to the Los Angeles City Clerk on December 2, 2016, with such certification attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the City Council that the canvass of votes is true and correct.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Los Angeles City Council hereby finds, determines, and declares that the total number of votes cast for and against City of Los Angeles Charter Amendment SSS at the Special Municipal Election by the qualified voters was 1,070,364 set forth in the certificate of the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk, and that Charter Amendment SSS, as proposed by Resolution of the City Council, is hereby declared to have been approved by a majority of the voters voting thereon.
