Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA). The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

#### SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on March 23, 2018, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered Resolution (Englander - Buscaino) and a CLA report relative to establishing the City's position regarding administrative action by the SCAQMD to utilize settlement proceeds, from a lawsuit against the Southern California Gas Company for the Aliso Canyon gas leak, for community amelioration benefits for impacted residents. The CLA report, attached to the Council file, provides additional background information and a summary of the Resolution.

After consideration, and after providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the accompanying Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
