HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY and HOUSING COMMITTEES' REPORT relative to adding Article 25 to Chapter 1, Division 10 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code (LAAC) to require a Project Labor Agreement (PLA) for Proposition HHH funded projects.

Recommendation for Council action:

REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare and present a final draft Ordinance adding Article 25 to Chapter 1, Division 10 of the LAAC to require a PLA for Proposition HHH funded projects that includes the following amendment:

Clarification that the PLA applies only to Fiscal Year 2018-19 bond issues and future ones.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On February 7, 2018, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered the City Attorney report and draft ordinance dated December 1, 2017 adding Article 25 to Chapter 1, Division 10 of the LAAC to require a PLA for Proposition HHH funded projects.

A representative from the City Attorney's Office provided some background on the matter and responded to questions from the Committee members. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee made a request to the City Attorney to amend the draft ordinance and clarify that the PLA applies only to Fiscal Year 2018-19 bond issues and future ones. On February 14, 2018, the Housing Committee considered this matter and concurred with the action taken by the Homelessness and Poverty Committee. The matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
