

INFORMATION, TECHNOLOGY, AND GENERAL SERVICES COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a sublicense agreement with the Hope of the Valley Rescue Mission for the use of a Day Laborer Resource Center located at 11839 Sherman Way.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Department of General Services to negotiate and execute a new sub-license agreement with Hope of the Valley Rescue Mission for the City-owned property located at 11839 Sherman Way under the terms and substantially as outlined in the Municipal Facilities Committee (MFC) report dated February 16, 2021, attached to the Council file.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The MFC reports that funding in the amount of up to \$175,000 in General Fund dollars is available in the EWDD's Adopted 2020-21 Budget for the Day Laborer Center contract with Hope of the Valley Rescue Mission.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY
