### RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Mayor:

1. Approve the proposed resolution to authorize the Cooperative Purchase Agreement 47423 with Network Television Time, Inc. providing (i) a potential term of approximately 79 months beginning April 1, 2017 and expiring on November 4, 2023, and (ii) a total expenditure authority not to exceed \$996,060; and
2. Return the proposed resolution to the Department for further processing, including City Council consideration.

### SUMMARY

Approval of the proposed resolution and Cooperative Purchase Agreement 47423 (Agreement) with Network Television Time, Inc. (NTT), which was originally awarded by the County of Los Angeles in November 2014, will enable the Department of Water and Power (DWP) to continue providing live and on-demand video feeds of the DWP Board of Commissioners (Board) meetings and special events. The proposed Agreement provides a total term of up to 79 months which consists of an initial term of 55 months and an optional extension of 24 months. The request also provides an expenditure authority not to exceed \$996,060 over the duration of the contract term including the optional extension period.

City Council approval is required pursuant to Charter Section 373. In accordance with the Los Angeles Administrative Code Section 10.5, unless the Council takes action disapproving the proposed Agreement within 60 days after submission to the City Council, the Agreement will be deemed approved. The City Attorney has approved the proposed resolution as to form and legality.

**FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT**

Approval of the proposed resolution will provide expenditure authority up to \$996,060 impacting the Water Revenue Fund and Power Revenue Fund. There is no fiscal impact to the City General Fund.
