

PERSONNEL AND ANIMAL WELFARE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the exemption of one Risk Management and Prevention Program Manager for the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD), from the Civil Service provisions of the City Charter.

Recommendation for Council action:

APPROVE the exemption of one Risk Management and Prevention Program Manager (Class Code 7982) for the LAFD, from the Civil Service provisions of the City Charter, pursuant to Charter Section 1001(b)(4).

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Mayor. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Summary:

On March 22, 2017, your Committee considered a March 2, 2017 communication from the Mayor relative to the exemption of one Risk Management and Prevention Program Manager (Class Code 7982) for the LAFD pursuant to Charter Section 1001(b)(4). According to the Mayor, the Risk Management and Prevention Program Manager position is responsible for managing the Certified Unified Program Agency Program, and all hazardous waste regulatory programs in the LAFD. Additionally, the position will manage the CalARP Program; Above Ground Petroleum Storage Act Program; two Hazardous Materials Release Response Plans and Inventories Programs; hazardous Waste Generator and Onsite Hazardous Waste Treatment Program; and Underground Storage Tank Program.

After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the exemption as detailed in the above recommendation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
