

MOTION

The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requires that all programs, services, and activities be accessible to persons with disabilities. In coordination with other City agencies, the Department on Disability (Department) helps ensure accessibility of such programs and services. In addition, online training on the ADA has been developed for City employees and is being updated as appropriate. It is appropriate that the City Council support the Department in its efforts to update the 2000 ADA Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan and provide training opportunities, among other efforts, to ensure continued accessibility by all.

I THEREFORE MOVE that all City Departments and Offices conduct a review of their status as it relates to the 2000 ADA Self Evaluation and Transition Plan (Plan), and with the assistance of the Department on Disability update the Plan as may be necessary.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department on Disability, with the assistance of all relevant City Departments, be instructed to report to Council on a bi-annual basis on the status of the ADA Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan (Plan) and the implementation of that Plan.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department on Disability, with the assistance of the Personnel Department, Information Technology Agency, and any other City Department as appropriate, be instructed to update existing online training programs regarding ADA compliance.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department on Disability, with the assistance of the Personnel Department, require the completion of its live and/or online ADA training module by all City employees on an annual basis.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Administrative Officer, with the assistance of the Department on Disability, be instructed to report within 90 days on the funding necessary to maintain compliance with ADA requirements.
