

HEALTH, EDUCATION AND NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCILS COMMITTEE
REPORT relative to the 2000 Americans with Disabilities Act Self-Evaluation and Transition
Plan.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Blumenfield - Ryu):

1. INSTRUCT all City Departments and Offices to conduct a review of their status as it relates to the 2000 ADA Self Evaluation and Transition Plan, and with the assistance of the Department on Disability and update their Plan as may be necessary.
2. INSTRUCT the Department on Disability (DOD) with the assistance of all relevant City Departments, be instructed to report to Council on a bi-annual basis on the status of the ADA Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan and the implementation of that Plan.
3. INSTRUCT the DOD with the assistance of the Personnel Department, Information Technology Agency, and any other City Department as appropriate, to update existing online training programs regarding ADA compliance.
4. DIRECT the DOD with the assistance of the Personnel Department to require the completion of its live and/or online ADA training module by all City employees on an annual basis.
5. INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer with the assistance of the DOD, to report on the funding necessary to maintain compliance with the ADA requirements.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On November 28, 2017, the Health, Education and Neighborhood Councils Committee considered Motion (Blumenfield - Ryu) relative to the 2000 Americans with Disabilities Act Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan.


