

ARTS, PARKS AND RIVER COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the Transgender Advisory Council and issues and topics affecting the Transgender community in the City on supportive services for the homeless, HIV/AIDS care, and job creation opportunities.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Bonin - O'Farrell - Koretz - Martinez):

1. REQUEST the Transgender Advisory Council (TAC) to report and make recommendations on issues and topics affecting the Transgender community in the City, including supportive services for the homeless, HIV/AIDS care, and job creation opportunities.
2. REQUEST the City Attorney, Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) and the Human Relations Commission, to work together and report back on whether the TAC is an official Brown Act body.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.


