Summary: All residents workers, students and visitors to Los Angeles are entitled to and have the right to a safe and healthy environment. To the extent that the comprehensive analysis called for in the report associated with Council File 17-0447 finds that adverse health and environmental impacts are associated within a to-be-determined distance from petroleum and gas wells, then we endorse imposition of a setback/buffer from such wells that is necessary to mitigate those impacts. It has been suggested in the paper titled "Existing scientific literature on setback distances from oil and gas development sites" that a 2,500 foot minimum setback be the requirement. Any recommendations emerging from this analysis must be subject to review by the public and affected owners before any such imposition is created. If measures other than a setback can reasonably be implemented that would result in the same safety and health benefits, they should be considered.
