

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Sections 80.00(h) and 80.53 to amend the definition of Parkway and prohibit the stopping, standing, or parking of a vehicle in the Parkway.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE dated May 22, 2017, amending LAMC Sections 80.00(h) and 80.53 to amend the definition of Parkway and prohibit the stopping, standing, or parking of a vehicle in the Parkway.

Fiscal Impact Statement Submitted: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On June 14, 2017, your Committee considered a May 22, 2017 City Attorney report and Ordinance relative to amending the LAMC Sections 80.00(h) and 80.53 to amend the definition of "Parkway" and prohibit the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicle in the Parkway. On May 16, 2017, pursuant to Motion (O'Farrell - Bonin), Council requested the City Attorney to prepare and present an Ordinance amending the LAMC to make it illegal to park any vehicle in the area of the road right-of-way between the sidewalk and the curb that is reserved for trees, landscaping, utilities and not intended for vehicles. A representative from the City Attorney presented an overview of the Ordinance provisions and answered questions from the Committee members. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Ordinance. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
