

IMMIGRANT AFFAIRS, CIVIL RIGHTS, AND EQUITY (IACRE) COMMITTEE REPORT relative to an ordinance to require City contractor disclosures relating to the proposed border wall between the United States and Mexico.

Recommendation for Council action:

REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare and present a new Ordinance adding Article 24 to Chapter 1, Division 10 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code (LAAC) to require any company doing business with the City to disclose all contracts, bids or proposals to provide goods or services for the design, construction, operation or maintenance of a Federally funded wall, fence or other barrier along the border between the United States and Mexico, and to amend the definition of Section 10.50.1 of the LAAC to include the following language:

This does not apply to companies that have an existing indefinite delivery, indefinite quantity contract that took effect on or before March 17, 2017.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a regular meeting held on December 7, 2017 the IACRE Committee considered a City Attorney report and Ordinance regarding City contractor disclosures related to Federal border wall, fence or other barrier. After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to request the City Attorney to prepare and present a new Ordinance with an amendment to the definition on Section 10.50.1 of the LAAC. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
