

NEIGHBORHOODS AND COMMUNITY ENRICHMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a Supplemental Agreement to Contract No. C-129781 with Western University of Health Sciences College of Veterinary Medicine, to provide spay/neuter and related veterinary services at the East Valley Animal Services Center.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE retroactively the General Manager, Department of Animal Services, or designee, to execute a Supplemental Agreement to Contract No. C-129781 between the Animal Services Department and Western University of Health Sciences College of Veterinary Medicine, to provide spay/neuter and related veterinary services at the East Valley Animal Services Center, located at 14409 Vanowen Street, Van Nuys, in Council District 6, from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2024, for an amount not to exceed \$350,000 per year, for a total of \$3,050,000.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that approval of the recommendation will have no additional impact on the General Fund. All spay and neuter service costs are funded through the Animal Sterilization Trust Fund and sufficient funding for this purpose is available therein.

Financial Policies Statement: The CAO further reports that the recommendation stated in this report complies with the City's Financial Policies in that budgeted funds are used for the intended purposes and ongoing revenues are used for ongoing expenditures.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.
