


MOTION

I MOVE that the matter of the PUBLIC HEARING relative to the establishment of an Underground Utility District in conformance with Ordinance No. 145148 along portions of the area bounded by the 101 Freeway on the east, 7th Street on the south, 4th Street on the north, and Mateo Street on the west (CF# 17-0724; Item No. 17 on today's Council Agenda) include the following actions for Council consideration upon completion of the public hearing:

- REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare and present a Resolution to declare and establish the Underground Utility District (UUD) within the specified area and in conformance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 145148, and any applicable City or State requirements;
- INSTRUCT the City Clerk to schedule the Resolution for Council consideration upon submittal by the City Attorney;
- INSTRUCT the Department of Transportation, in collaboration with the Department of Water & Power and the Bureau of Engineering, to provide traffic control plans for all Department of Water and Power work related to the construction of the UUD;
- INSTRUCT the Bureau of Engineering to serve as the City's project manager for the proposed UUD;
- INSTRUCT the Bureau of Engineering to expedite the processing of all utility permits associated with the UUD;
- INSTRUCT the Bureau of Engineering, upon the preparation of all required documentation, to grant Peak Hour Exemptions, Holiday Moratorium Exemptions, and Transportation Construction Traffic Management Committee (TCTMC) waivers for all work by the Department of Water and Power related to the UUD;
- INSTRUCT the Department of Building & Safety to assist private property owners with the necessary permits required to convert their properties to receive underground electrical service in an expedited manner; and
- REQUEST the Board of Public Works to exempt the Department of Water and Power from the Above Ground Facilities Ordinance for all electric vehicle charging stations and related equipment within the project area.
