

The Fourteenth Council District (CD 14) has received a request to donate two vans and an assortment of fire equipment, including nine rescue air cushions and fans, two portable monitors, one hose pallet, thirty gurneys, and one hundred emergency medical service boxes to the Federation of Zacatecan International Benefit Organization, Inc., a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt non-profit organization that provides Los Angeles immigrant residents with charitable services such as medical care, grants for education, and free language training. The Federation of Zacatecan International Benefit Organization would like to expand its services across the Los Angeles region to assist a greater number of immigrant residents integrate into their respective communities.

Section 22.547 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code provides that upon Council approval, surplus City equipment may be sold for less than market value to a non-profit organization located in the City of Los Angeles, which has been established exclusively to further the services provided by the City and its departments. The Federation of Zacatecan International Benefit Organization has a location at 1332 Miller Ave, 90063, in the City of Los Angeles. This donation of two (2) vans and fire equipment will further the Federation of Zacatecan International Benefit Organization’s humanitarian purpose and assist a greater number of Los Angeles residents with language training and free medical care. Assisting Los Angeles residents originating from Zacatecas, Mexico, furthers the Federation of Zacatecan International Benefit Organization’s mission by assisting immigrants with social and economic integration. The combined fair market value of the fire equipment and both vans are \$5,330, which will be foregone revenue should it be donated.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council:

1. Find that the Federation of Zacatecan International Benefit Organization, is eligible to purchase two surplus 2001 GMC Sierra 2500 Cargo Vans (VIN # 1GTGG25R111138476 and VIN #1GTGG25R611135704), nine rescue air cushions and fans, two portable monitors, one hose pallet, thirty (30) gurneys, and one hundred (100) emergency medical service boxes at below market value (\$2.00), in accordance with LAAC Sec. 22.547 (Donation of Surplus City Equipment), as the recipient is a nonprofit organization that has been established exclusively to further the services provided by the City; and
2. Request the City Attorney to write a contract to effectuate the sale and transfer of the above identified surplus equipment at below market value to the Federation of Zacatecan International Benefit Organization; and
3. Instruct the City Clerk to inform the Federation of Zacatecan International Benefit Organization [Jorge Ortiz, 1332 Miller Ave, 90063, (626) 536-4416] that the surplus equipment must be claimed within 60 days from the date of Council approval of the request after which time it will revert to the City’s surplus equipment pool for disposal by the Department of General Services.
