PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to accepting responsibility for maintenance of the Go Avenue 26 Project paint treatment as part of the TransitCenter grant.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Cedillo - Englander):

- 1. ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION that accepts responsibility for maintenance of the Go Avenue 26 Project paint treatment at three State of California, Department of Transportation (Caltrans) underpass walls and ceilings as part of the TransitCenter grant of \$147,850 to LA-Mas, and any repairs of the improvements deemed necessary by the City and Caltrans.
- 2. AUTHORIZE the Board of Public Works to make any technical corrections or clarifications to this matter in order to effectuate the intent of this motion.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.
