On October 29, 2018, the Board of Public Works approved the Bureau of Sanitation's (BOS) *Environmental Impact Report (Addendum No. 2)* and the *Facility Certification Program Plan* for the RecycLA Program. The RecycLA Program is the Citywide Exclusive Franchise System for solid resource collection and handling.


According to the BOS, the *Addendum* and the *Facility Certification Program Plan* seek to establish requirements for public health, environmental protection and workplace safety at solid resources facilities utilized in the RecycLA Program.

In order to better understand these matters, it would be appropriate for the Council to assert jurisdiction over the Board's action and conduct its own review.


