

**MOTION**

I HEREBY MOVE that the Council ADOPT the following recommendations of the City Attorney in order to effect settlement in the case entitled William K. W. Yao v. City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. BC598202 (this case involves a traffic accident which occurred on September 7, 2014, at Reseda Boulevard and Brasilia Drive), **SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:**

1. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to expend up to \$7,500,000 in settlement of the above-entitled matter.
2. AUTHORIZE the Controller to make the following transfers:
  - a. \$3,750,000 from Liability Claims Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009798, Miscellaneous Liability Payouts, to Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009795, Public Works, Street Services Liability Payouts.
  - b. \$3,750,000 from Liability Claims Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009798, Miscellaneous Liability Payouts, to Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009797, Transportation Liability Payouts.
3. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney draw demands from Fund No. 100/59 as follows:
  - a. \$3,400,000 from Account No. 009795, Public Works, Street Services Liability Payouts, made payable to Law Office of David Roark, and William Yao.
  - b. \$350,000 from Account No. 009795, Public Works, Street Services Liability Payouts, made payable to Pacific Life & Annuity Services, Inc.
  - c. \$3,400,000 from Account No. 009797, Transportation Liability Payouts, made payable to Law Office of David Roark, and William Yao.
  - d. \$350,000 from Account No. 009797, Transportation Liability Payouts, made payable to Pacific Life & Annuity Services, Inc.
4. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney, or designee, to make necessary technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer; and, AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.

This matter was recommended for approval by the Budget and Finance Committee (Krekorian – Koretz – Blumenfield: “Yes”) at its meeting on September 18, 2017, in Closed Session as permitted by Government Code Section 54956.9(d)(1).
