
MOTION

On September 6, 2017, the Council approved a motion to transfer funding for a much-needed sidewalk on the northern side of Alhambra Avenue adjacent to El Sereno Arroyo Playground and additional safe pedestrian crossing locations along the roadway (C.F. 17-0985). Since that time, the Bureau of Street Services has begun implementation work, which is anticipated to be completed in June 2018. Additional funding, however, is needed to complete the new sidewalk construction. The funding will be provided by the Local Transportation Fund and backfilled from the Community Redevelopment Agency Los Angeles (CRA/LA) Excess Bond Proceeds from the Adelante Eastside Project Area for the Breed Street and Sheridan Street Elementary School Safe Routes to School Project (see C.F. 14-1174-S28 and 17-0985).

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor, AUTHORIZE the transfer of \$171,000 from the Local Transportation Funds 207, Account No. 94PD16, Active Transportation Program (ATP) Cycle 1 SRTS Bike/Pedestrian Rehabilitation to the Capital Improvement Expenditure Program (CIEP) Fund No. 100/54 Alhambra Avenue Safety Improvements Account No. 00P290.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department of Transportation be authorized to make any technical changes as necessary to effectuate the intent of this motion.
