PURPOSE OPERATING AGREEMENT 17-3515 BETWEEN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES

HARBOR DEPARTMENT AND MOLEX, LLC. FTZ 202, SITE 51

As approved by the Board of Harbor Commissioners on August 10, 2017 and pursuant to Section 373 of the City Charter & Section 10.5 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, enclosed for your approval is Resolution No. 17-8144 authorizing the approval of Foreign-Trade Zone (FTZ) Operating Agreement 17-3515 between the City of Los Angeles Harbor Department and Molex, LLC. to operate its warehouse within FTZ 202, Site 51, located in Rancho Cucamonga, California, for an initial five-year term, with three subsequent five-year renewal options. There is no impact to the General Fund.
