ARTS, ENTERTAINMENT, PARKS AND RIVER COMMITTEE REPORT relative to accepting responsibility for the maintenance and repair of the Little Armenia Gateway Public Art Project located on the parcel adjacent to the 101 Freeway exit on Hollywood Boulevard at Van Ness Street (Project).

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (O'Farrell - Krekorian):

1. ADOPT the accompanying Resolution that the City accepts responsibility for maintenance and repair of the Project; and, AUTHORIZE the Councilmember, Council District 13, and the Department of Cultural Affairs (DCA), with the assistance of the City Attorney, to execute any required agreements or documents with the State of California, Department of Transportation, as may be necessary, to implement the Project.

2. AUTHORIZE the DCA to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of the Motion.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.


Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on September 27, 2017, your Arts, Entertainment, Parks and River Committee considered a Motion (O'Farrell - Krekorian) and Resolution relative to accepting responsibility for the maintenance and repair of the Project. The Motion states that in order to secure the necessary permit(s) from Caltrans for the installation of the Project, a City Resolution is required that confirms the City agrees to be responsible for the Project's maintenance and necessary repair or other improvements. This work will be managed as needed through the DCA. After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations contained in the Motion as amended, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
