

PLANNING AND LAND USE MANAGEMENT (PLUM) COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the feasibility of revising the Ventura - Cahuenga Boulevard Corridor Specific Plan.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Blumenfield - Koretz - Krekorian - Ryu - Huizar):

- 1. INSTRUCT the Department of City Planning (DCP), with the assistance of the Los Angeles Department of Transportation, City Administrative Officer (CAO), and the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), to prepare a report in 60 days that identifies options for amending, supplementing, overlaying by neighborhood, or revising the Ventura- Cahuenga Boulevard Corridor Specific Plan, including information on the costs, staffing needs, and timeline for each option as well as the identification of funding sources to meet those options.
- 2. INSTRUCT the DCP, with the assistance of the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment, to report back on options for creating a robust public participation process that will allow each of the six neighborhoods within it to robustly contribute on an continual basis throughout.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a regular meeting held on November 7, 2017, the PLUM Committee considered a Motion (Blumenfield - Koretz - Krekorian - Ryu - Huizar) relative to the feasibility of revising the Ventura - Cahuenga Boulevard Corridor Specific Plan. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council approve the Motion. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
