Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Englander - Koretz):

INSTRUCT the Personnel Department to report on:

- a. Classifications of employees of the City, who, as a result of their employment duties and responsibilities, come into regular contact with individuals who may be infected with Hepatitis A and should receive a vaccination against the disease.
- b. Vaccinations expanding to employees of the Library Department.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.



Summary:

At a regular meeting held on February 21, 2018, the Personnel and Animal Welfare Committee considered Motion (Englander - Koretz) regarding City employees exposure to Hepatitis A. Representatives of Personnel Department, Medical Services identified employees with high risk of contact and provided the number of vaccines issued to City employees. After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to approve the Motion, and for Medical Services to expand vaccinations to employees of the Library Department. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
