

MOTION

On September 28, 2018, the City Council approved an ordinance to implement Dockless On-Demand Personal Mobility Rules and Guidelines to govern and permit the operation of bicycles, electric bicycles, and electric scooters in the City.

Both the City's regulations and the California Vehicle Code Section 21235 clearly prohibit scooter riding on the sidewalk, except as may be necessary to enter or leave adjacent property. This restriction, however, is often unknown to scooter riders and has led to numerous accidents. The City should take strong steps to keep scooter riders off of sidewalks to reduce this hazard for pedestrians.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council instruct the Department of Transportation to fabricate and install signs, at the request of any Council office, that clearly display the prohibition of riding a scooter on a City sidewalk.
