

MOTION

In December 2017, City Council adopted a motion (CF 17-1226-S1) relative to allocating funding for the 7th Street Streetscape Improvements Project. The Housing & Community Investment Department (HCIDLA) is requesting the following technical clarifications.

Skid Row Housing Trust (SRHT), in conjunction with HCIDLA the received an Affordable Housing and Sustainable Communities (AHSC) Sustainable Transportation Infrastructure (STI) grant from the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) for the construction of street improvements on 7th Street between Olive and San Pedro. SRHT has agreed that the City should serve as the agency responsible for designing and constructing the STI portion of the project in conformance with the AHSC STI grant requirements and the City's other projects. The STI Budget totals \$1,931,000. SRHT is responsible for the housing component and program costs in the amount of \$100,000 STI Grant for construction of bike share station at 11 th St and Wall St and \$84,000 Program Costs (PGM) Grant for SCAG Go Human (bus shelters marketing) and Bike Share Operations and Maintenance associated with the AHSC Disbursement Agreement.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor, to direct the HCIDLA to coordinate the implementation and reimbursement process of up to \$1,931,000 in AHSC Round 2 grant funding from Skid Row Housing Trust's AHSC Round 2 grant awarded funds for STI "7 th Street Streetscape Improvements" project. Furthermore, for HCIDLA to coordinate with the BOE and other City Departments as necessary to prepare the reimbursement requests to fully reimburse the City for the implementation of up to \$1,931,000 for the STI scope of work as awarded by the AHSC grant program, Round 2.
