

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to conducting a traffic study of the area bounded by South Cochran Avenue, Rimpau Boulevard, Venice Boulevard and West Olympic Boulevard to address an anticipated increase in traffic generated by several new developments.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Wesson – Ryu):

INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) to conduct a traffic study of the area bounded by South Cochran Avenue, Rimpau Boulevard, Venice Boulevard, and West Olympic Boulevard to address an anticipated increase in traffic generated by several new developments.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.


SUMMARY

On November 3, 2017, Council considered Motion (Wesson – Ryu) instructing LADOT to conduct a traffic study of the area bounded by South Cochran Avenue, Rimpau Boulevard, Venice Boulevard, and West Olympic Boulevard to address an anticipated increase in traffic generated by several new developments. Motion states there are several new developments proposed in this area. Simultaneously constructed, the construction of these projects could result in cumulative traffic issues, such as congestion and/or safety issues, that could negatively affect the surrounding community. Council referred Motion to the Transportation Committee for consideration.

At its meeting held March 28, 2018, the Transportation Committee recommended that Council approve Motion's recommendation.
