

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to establishing an Illegal Fireworks Task Force.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (O'Farrell - Ryu):

INSTRUCT the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), with the assistance of the Los Angeles Police Department, the Los Angeles Fire Department, and the City Attorney, to report back in 60 days on issues related to illegal fireworks and steps that could be taken to curtail their use within the City, including but not limited to:

- a. Issues hindering effective illegal fireworks enforcement.
- b. Quantitative data on the number of calls for service related to fireworks and their geographic location.
- c. Education and outreach strategies.
- d. Enforcement strategies.
- e. Legislative and/or administrative action(s) at the Federal, State or local level.
- f. Examples of successful strategies from other jurisdictions.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a regular meeting held on January 24, 2018, the Public Safety Committee considered Motion (O'Farrell - Ryu) regarding an Illegal Fireworks Task Force. Councilmember O'Farrell read into the record an amendment to the Motion. After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to approve the Motion as amended. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
