Summary: The LHNC opposes the Council File because: The Lincoln Heights NC has voted to oppose the development of 5 DOT lots in Lincoln Heights. Therefore, the LHNC is against the adoption of the city ordinance as written as it affects the DOT lots development. The ordinance should include rules regarding the number of maximum units developed in each 97 neighborhood council areas. The ordinance should include the rules for replacing parking when supportive housing is built on city owned DOT lots. Without these definitions, the impact of large developments on small neighborhoods is an unfair burden for one community. This Community Impact Statement is based on the action taken at the special Board of Directors meeting on March 15, 2018, when the Lincoln Heights Neighborhood Council adopted the following motion by a vote of 15 yes, 1 no, ` abstaining and directed that a Community Impact Statement be filed reflecting its position.
