ADOPT the accompanying revised RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2017-18 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for legislation and/or administrative action to identify State-owned properties that can be used as housing and/or facilities to address homelessness.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on June 29, 2018, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered Resolution (Huizar - Harris-Dawson) and a CLA report and revised Resolution relative to establishing the City's position regarding legislation and/or administrative action to identify State-owned properties that can be used as housing and/or facilities to address homelessness.
