

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the establishment of parking restrictions on both sides of Crocker Street and South San Pedro Street between Slauson Avenue (north border) and East 59th Place (south border) in Council District Nine.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Price - Ryu):

1. RESOLVE, pursuant pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4 and California Vehicle Code Section 22507, to hereby prohibit the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over seven feet in height, during the hours of 2:00 am and 6:00 am on both sides of Crocker Street and South San Pedro Street between Slauson Avenue (north border) and East 59th Place (south border).
2. DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), upon approval of this action, to post signs giving notice of a *Tow Away, No Parking* restriction for oversize vehicles on the streets listed above in Recommendation No. 1.
3. AUTHORIZE the LADOT to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On February 14, 2018, your Committee considered a Resolution (Price - Ryu) relative to the establishment of parking restrictions on both sides of Crocker Street and South San Pedro Street between Slauson Avenue (north border) and East 59th Place (south border) in Council District Nine. According to the Resolution, the residences along a segment of Crocker Street and South San Pedro Street are experiencing public safety issues associated with large vehicles that are parking overnight and constricting travel lanes, thereby creating a dangerous situation. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Resolution as detailed in the above recommendations. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
