

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to establishing oversized vehicle parking restrictions along a segment of Iowa Avenue.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Bonin – O’Farrell):

1. RESOLVE, pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4 and California Vehicle Code Section 22507, to hereby prohibit the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over seven feet in height, during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., along Iowa Avenue between Amherst and Centinela Avenues.
2. DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), upon approval of this action, to post signs giving notice of a Tow Away, No Parking restriction for oversized vehicles on the street listed above with the specific hours detailed above.
3. AUTHORIZE the LADOT to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this action.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.


### SUMMARY

On August 1, 2018, Council considered Resolution (Bonin – O’Farrell) relative to establishing oversized vehicle parking restrictions along a segment of Iowa Avenue. Resolution states that there is an increased problem with oversized vehicles parking on streets in West Los Angeles, immediately adjacent to residential buildings. The parking of large vehicles results in fewer parking spaces for residents and visitors, as well as limited visibility for drivers on these narrow residential streets. Resolution recommends the establishment of oversized vehicle parking restrictions for this area. Council referred Resolution to the Transportation Committee for consideration.

At its meeting held August 8, 2018, the Transportation Committee recommended that Council approve Resolution establishing oversized vehicle parking restrictions along a segment of Iowa Avenue.
