

MOTION

On April 5, 2011, the Council approved the addition of Section 87.55 to Chapter VIII of the Los Angeles Municipal Code that establishes regulations for the parking of vehicles displaying a "For Sale" sign or placard advertising the private sale of that vehicle. After conducting a public hearing, Section 87.55 allows the City Council to amend this Section to include additional streets or public lands.

A large number of vehicles are consistently parked on a portion of South Western Avenue (State Route 213) the sole purpose of displaying them for private sale. This situation is monopolizing on-street parking and creating visual blight in the surrounding communities. The current maintenance agreement between the City and the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) authorizes maintenance work to be performed by the City along this State Highway, including the posting and maintenance of signage.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council request the City Attorney, in conjunction with the Los Angeles Department of Transportation and the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), to prepare and present an ordinance amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 87.55, which establishes regulations for the parking of vehicles for private sale on certain City streets or public lands, to prohibit the parking of such vehicles with a "For Sale" sign on the east side of South Western Avenue (State Route 213) within the City of Los Angeles between West 182nd Street and West Paseo Del Mar.
