relative to a Civil and Human Rights Ordinance.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Wesson - Cedillo - Martinez):

REQUEST the City Attorney, with the assistance from the City's Immigrant Affairs and Civil Rights Advocate, Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), and any other City department as necessary, to prepare and present a draft Civil and Human Rights Ordinance that:

- a. Prohibits discrimination, prejudice, intolerance and bigotry that results in denial of equal treatment of any individual.
- b. Provides remedies accessible to complainants.
- c. Creates the City of Los Angeles Civil and Human Rights Commission and any other supporting unit to investigate and enforce violations of the proposed Ordinance.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a regular meeting held on February 1, 2018, the IACRE Committee considered Motion (Wesson - Cedillo - Martinez) regarding a Civil and Human Rights Ordinance. After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended on consent to approve the Motion. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
