

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to establish a late submission penalty for businesses that fail to timely file a Hazardous Materials Business Plan.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE, dated February 25, 2019, adding Section 57.121.3.5 to Article 7, Chapter V of the LAMC to establish a late submission penalty for businesses that fail to timely file a hazardous material business plan in accordance with Section 57.121 of the LAMC and Chapter 6.95, Article 1 of the California Health and Safety Code.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on March 27, 2019, the Public Safety Committee considered a City Attorney Report and Ordinance relative to amending the LAMC to establish a late submission penalty for businesses that fail to timely file a Hazardous Materials Business Plan.
