

CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION and TRADE, TRAVEL, AND TOURISM COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the Fourth Amendment to the Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) contract with AT and T Mobility National Accounts, LLC (ATT), for ongoing wireless, voice, and related mobile services, and equipment purchases.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. ADOPT the determination by the Board of Airport Commissioners that the proposed action is categorically exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in accordance with Article III, Class 1(18)(c) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.
2. APPROVE the Fourth Amendment to LAWA Contract DA-4765 with ATT, extending the term through December 31, 2020, and increasing the amount by \$1,760,000, for new total not to exceed \$8,912,000, for ongoing wireless, voice, and related mobile services, and equipment purchases.
3. CONCUR with the action taken by the Board of Airport Commissioners on November 21, 2019, by Resolution No. 26893, authorizing the Chief Executive Officer, LAWA, to execute the Fourth Amendment to Contract DA-4765 with ATT.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The Board of Airport Commissioners reports that this action will not impact the General Fund.

SUMMARY

On November 21, 2019, the Board of Airport Commissioners approved Fourth Amendment to the LAWA contract with ATT. Extending the contract and increasing the contract authority will ensure continued service and best pricing for the duration of the existing Nevada National Association of State Procurement Officials contract. LAWA currently has approximately 1,975 wireless subscribers with ATT for an estimated expenditure of more than \$1,000,000 per year for cellular/data communications equipment and services. Additionally, LAWA uses a wide array of mobile services that are vital to security, safety, and airport operations.

At its meeting held December 3, 2019, the Trade, Travel, and Tourism Committee recommended that Council approve the Fourth Amendment to the LAWA contract with ATT, as recommended by the Board of Airport Commissioners.
