MOTION

On April 16, 2018, the Mayor announced that his proposed FY 18-19 Budget would make a significant allocation of funding for the purpose of creating temporary crisis and bridge housing for the city's unsheltered homeless to have a habitable place to stay instead of our city's sidewalks, underpasses, parks, and any of the many other places where our neighborhoods find encampments.

In order to best protect these funds and preserve them for the intended purpose of developing new temporary housing for the homeless, the Council should consider the creation of a new Special Fund devoted to Crisis and Bridge Housing.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council REQUEST that the City Attorney draft an ordinance to create a new Special Fund entitled the "Crisis and Bridge Housing Fund" to be used for the purpose of developing new temporary crisis and bridge housing facilities and safe parking locations for the homeless, and that the fund have a sunset date of July 1, 2028, with any unspent balances within the fund reverting to the general fund upon the sunset of the ordinance.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Council REQUEST that the City Controller, upon the establishment of the fund, create accounts within the Crisis and Bridge Housing Fund for each Council district as well as an account for citywide use, and that any unencumbered balances within the Council district accounts as of December 31, 2018 be transferred to the Citywide account on January 1, 2019.
