The Board of Airport Commissioners (BOAC) desires to authorize its Chief Executive Officer to use alternative project delivery methods and the competitive sealed proposal selection process for the Receiving Station (RS-X) Project and related capital improvement projects at Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) consistent with City Charter Sections 371 and 375. This Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality, which would accomplish BOAC's goal.

These projects are highly specialized and time is of the essence, making it critically important that the contractors have the expertise and experience to perform the projects in an accurate and timely manner. According to the BOAC, the effect of the enclosed draft ordinance, if adopted, would be to enable LAWA to most effectively meet these objectives.
