PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to designating the area between the intersections at Vernon Avenue and Crenshaw Boulevard, 43rd Street and Crenshaw Boulevard, Leimert Boulevard and 43rd Street, Leimert Boulevard and Vernon Avenue, and Degnan Boulevard and 43rd Street as Historic Leimert Park Village.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Wesson - Harris-Dawson):

1. DESIGNATE the area between the intersections at Vernon Avenue and Crenshaw Boulevard, 43rd Street and Crenshaw Boulevard, Leimert Boulevard and 43rd Street, Leimert Boulevard and Vernon Avenue, and Degnan Boulevard and 43rd Street as Historic Leimert Park Village.
2. INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation to fabricate and install appropriate ceremonial sign(s) to this effect at this location.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on May 15, 2019, the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee considered a Motion (Wesson - Harris-Dawson) relative to designating the area between the intersections at Vernon Avenue and Crenshaw Boulevard, 43rd Street and Crenshaw Boulevard, Leimert Boulevard and 43rd Street, Leimert Boulevard and Vernon Avenue, and Degnan Boulevard and 43rd Street as Historic Leimert Park Village. After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations contained in the Motion as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
