

CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION and PLANNING AND LAND USE MANAGEMENT (PLUM) COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the inclusion of Rancho El Escorpion Lime Kiln located at El Escorpion Park between Bell Canyon Road and intersection of Castle Peak Drive and Woodland Lane in the list of Historic-Cultural Monuments.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. FIND that this action is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), pursuant to Article 19, Section 15308, Class Eight, and Article 19, Section 15331, Class 31 of State CEQA Guidelines.
2. ADOPT the findings of the Cultural Heritage Commission (CHC) as the findings of the Council.
