SUMMARY

At the meeting held on June 6, 2018, your Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee considered a a BPW report relative to authoring the OCB to continue present contracts for graffiti removal and community beautification services. The OCB reports that the original contract with these contractors was developed in 2013, and through amendments, the BPW has been able to extend contracts until June 2018. Council authority would allow the BPW to authorize the extension of these contracts through December 2018, with an additional six month renewal option if needed. It is the intention of OCB to create an RFP for community beautification services during Fiscal Year 2018-19. After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee moved to approve the BPW's recommendations, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
