SUBJECT:

Trojan Way – Private Driveway Name Establishment at San Pablo Street Northerly of Alcazar Street

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- A. That the name of the private driveway on San Pablo Street Northerly of Alcazar Street, shown on Exhibit “A”, be established as Trojan Way (Private Driveway).
- B. That the Council, find that the name establishment is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, pursuant to Article III, Class 5(4) of the City’s Environmental Guidelines.
- C. That the City Clerk be instructed to transmit the following:
  1. A copy of the City Council’s action on this matter to the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles pursuant to Section 34092 of the Government Code.

DISCUSSION:


Request: The petitioner, University of Southern California, Attn: Brian League, is requesting the City to establish the name of the private driveway lying on San Pablo Street Northerly of Alcazar Street, as shown on Exhibit "A", as Trojan Way.

The name establishment for the private driveway is required to identify the university parking structure access.

The naming of the private driveway does not signify that it is either a public street or approved private street and is for identification purposes only.
