

MOTION

On Friday, June 1, 2018, the Board of Harbor Commissioners was notified by the California Workforce Development Board and Employment Development Department of the award of an additional grant of \$100,000 for the High Road Training Partnership Grant. The grant acceptance documents must be approved, signed and delivered to the State no later than June 15, 2018.

The purpose of the grant program is to promote the development of training programs created from partnerships between labor unions and their management counterparts. The Harbor Department received the original grant award of \$500,000 for this program in May 2017. The new, additional, grant is to be used to help the Harbor Department efforts to work with labor unions and their management counterparts to create new and innovative training programs.

I THEREFORE MOVE that pursuant to Section 245(b) of the Los Angeles City Charter, the Council hereby RESOLVE to waive review of the anticipated action of the Board of Harbor Commissioners to accept the grant of \$100,000 from the California Workforce Development Board and Employment Development Department for the High Road Training Partnership program, as further detailed in the text of this Motion.
