

MOTION

The Goodyear Tract industrial complex covers 205 acres and includes over 200 diverse companies. This large district is a historic and active industrial area and an important economic engine for the neighborhoods of south Los Angeles.

Additional business activity in the area has generated an increase in traffic on the streets adjacent to the complex. It is critical that a comprehensive transportation study be undertaken to examine the situation and present innovative proposals. The study should include quantifying vehicular and truck traffic volumes, an analysis of ingress and egress patterns, and an examination of pedestrian activity, including the number of school children who traverse the area.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council instruct the Department of Transportation to conduct a comprehensive transportation study around the Goodyear Tract to determine innovative options that will address the increased traffic and pedestrian activity and present the findings and recommendations from the study to the Council.
